

#### **OHIO CONSERVATION FARM FAMILY AWARD**

The Ohio Conservation Farm Family Awards program recognizes farmers who are doing an outstanding job of protecting and conserving soil, water and related natural resources on the land they farm. Coordinated by the Ohio Department of Agriculture, Division of Soil and Water Conservation and co-sponsored by Ohio Farmer magazine and the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation, the program emphasizes the application of technically sound, innovative and cost-effective conservation practices and encourages the sharing of this information with other farmers and the general public. All five finalists will be recognized as winners of the Ohio Conservation Farm Family Award at a ceremony during the Farm Science Review in September and will be featured in the September issue of Ohio Farmer magazine. STARK SOIL & WATER IS ONCE AGAIN OFFERING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS AN OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN MUSKINGUM WATERSHED CONSERVANCY DISTRICT'S COVER CROP PROGRAM. LAST YEAR, 1,734 ACRES OF FUNDED COVER CROP ACRES WERE PLANTED IN STARK COUNTY, RESULTING IN THE REDUCTION OF 3,223 TONS OF SEDIMENT ENTERING WATERWAYS. ADDITIONALLY, ESSENTIAL PLANT NUTRIENTS -3,308 LBS. OF PHOSPHORUS AND 6,616 LBS. OF TOTAL NITROGEN- WERE KEPT IN THE SOIL PROFILE. #### It's time for Spring and what that means for storm water systems?

As temperatures rise with the onset of spring, an important storm water issue will also unveil itself: snow melt.

Litter, which has been hidden under layers of snow, accumulates over winter. As the snow melts, litter will drain into storm systems that discharge into lakes, rivers, and streams. Although communities work to clean the streets during fair weather seasons, winter weather prevents them from doing so. The snow melt can also carry excess road salt particles into aquatic systems raising salinity levels and creating an environment where fish and plants struggle to survive. Fecal matter from dogs and other animals flows into storm water systems and transports bacteria into local waters. The bacteria can be harmful to aquatic organisms and limit recreation on surface waters.

What can you do?

- \* Pick up and dispose of litter along curbs and lawns
- \* Sweep up excess salt from driveways and sidewalks
- \* Clean up animal feces in your yard
- \* Observe the flow of water into storm drains and remove any unwanted debris
